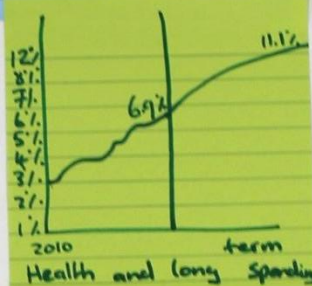

CONTRAST TO PREVIOUS GENERATIONS
